Braga is one of the oldest Portuguese cities, as well as one of the oldest Christian cities in the world. It was founded in Roman times, under the name of Bracara Augusta and, today, it boasts 2000 years of history as a city.

Remains of settlement in Braga date back thousands of years, certified as belonging to the Bronze Age.

The history of Braga can be divided in three periods: Pre-history, Bracara Augusta and Braga.

In the past 30 years, the district's population has grown by over 25%. Braga shows development and quality of life standards quite above the national average, only surpassed by the regions of Porto and Lisbon.

Braga is also one of the youngest cities in Europe, making it a dynamic and energetic city.

The city have a strategic geographical position and a unique development which make this Portuguese district one of the most appealing regions for investment.

Braga also offers cultural and leisure opportunities, with its nightlife, cinemas, theaters, exhibitions, museums and art galleries.

It is a city full of culture and traditions, where history and religion coexist side by side with the technology industry and academic life.

Located in the north of Portugal, in the Cávado Valley, Braga has roughly 200 thousand inhabitants.

It is the centre of the Great Metropolitan Area of Minho (GAM), totalling about 800 thousand inhabitants.

When Portugal as a country was constituted, Braga was its only city.

Guimarães Castle

One of Portugal's most iconic castles, the Guimarães Castle dates back to the 10th century and was initially built to defend the region from Moorish and Norman invasions.

Over time, it became associated with the birth of Portugal, as it was the alleged birthplace of the nation's first king, D. Afonso Henriques.

Palace of the Dukes of Braganza
